ADMISSION NOTICE – ONLY LL.B. (3 Years) COURSE
ACADEMIC YEAR 2026–27

As per the guidelines and directions of the CET Cell and Government, the admission process for the LL.B. (3 Years) course is initiated. Without the required documents and their verification, the admission process **shall not be** initiated and admission shall not be granted.

Documents Required:

1. Provisional Allotment letter
2. CET Option form
3. CET Online Application Form
4. CET Score Card
5. SSC Marksheet (Conversion certificate if required)
6. HSC Marksheet or Equivalent i.e. Engg. Diploma (Conversion certificate if required)
7. Graduation I, II and III year Marksheet (Along with Conversion certificate)
8. Domicile Certificate / Birth Certificate mentioning place of birth or School Leaving Certificate mentioning place of birth
9. Leaving Certificate / Transfer Certificate / Migration Certificate
10. Caste Certificate [For SC, ST, SEBC, VJ / DT, NT(B), NT(C), NT(D), O.B.C., S.B.C. from the State of Maharashtra only]
11. Caste Validity if required
12. Non Creamy layer valid up to 31 March 2027 [VJ / DT(A), NT(B), NT(C), NT(D), OBC (including SBC), SEBC]
13. EWS from the State of Maharashtra only
14. Aadhaar Card
15. PAN Card
16. Voter ID
17. Front Page of Passbook (Nationalized Bank)

18. Change in name Government gazette/ Marriage Certificate (if required)
19. Educational GAP Certificate if applicable
20. Employer NOC if you are in employment
21. Photo (Hard copy and soft copy) size 3cmx4cm, white background in jpeg format less than 1 mb size

Important Instructions:

1. The Conversion Certificate must be prepared by calculating marks of all years/semesters of the qualifying examination.
2. If there is any mismatch between the Conversion Certificate and the marks calculated by the Admission Committee, the admission shall be rejected/cancelled.
3. LL.B. (3 Years) students whose qualifying result is in CGPA/Grade must submit the University Ledger/Statement of Marks for all years/semesters.
4. Candidates having qualifications other than a regular three-year Degree for LL.B. must submit the required Equivalence Certificate as per rules.
5. All documents are subject to verification. No admission shall be given without the required documents.
